By Highway: It's no wonder why the 127-mile road from Anchorage to Seward is a National Scenic Byway and All-American Road. You may see beluga whales swimming, Dall sheep grazing, or eagles soaring as you make your way past hanging glaciers, quaint towns, and stunning mountain scenery.

By Rail: The Alaska Railroad follows a similar path, but includes a hidden backcountry route. Best yet, somebody else is driving so you can enjoy it all.

By Sea: By personal vessel or cruiseship, you'll travel the majestic waters of Resurrection Bay, replete with glacier-capped peaks and marine wildlife.

By Air: There is no regularly scheduled air service, but Seward does have a small airport for charter flights and flightseeing excursions.

Getting Around: On land, you can hop into a taxi, rent a bike or car or take advantage of various shuttles to get around town. By sea, sign up for a sightseeing trip or take a water taxi to the more remote hiking and kayaking destinations.
